

# Critical Infrastructure Attack

## Moore County, NC



At least one site exhibited characteristics of being mechanically breached

**Curfew in place from 9:00pm-5:00am.**



**Current Impacts:** ~35,000 citizens without power. Most county resources offline. LE, medical, and trash collection unaffected. Waste management/water treatment resources affected, to an unknown extent. Significant federal presence throughout the county, providing security along with local authorities. Curfew in place for locals from 9:00pm-5:00am. Military personnel exempt from curfew. Power is currently being cycled on/off for various communities as repairs are being made and resources are being shuffled around. No ETA on repair completion, but long-term repairs will likely take considerable time due to a global transformer shortage. Localized fuel shortages highly likely as generators and vehicles begin to run dry.

**Who:** Unknown  
**What:** Attack on 2x Electrical Substations w/ Small Arms  
**When:** 03 December, 2022 – Approximately 7:00pm  
**Where:** West End Substation, Carthage Substation – Moore County, NC  
**Why:** Motive unclear, earlier RUMINT that the attack had been committed by “right wing individuals” at a nearby Counter Degeneracy protest was unfounded.
