## Location of Customer Data at Rest

Microsoft will store Customer Data at rest within certain major geographic areas (each, a Geo) as follows:

Office 365 Services. If Customer provisions its tenant in Australia, the European Union, India, Japan or the United States (each of the foregoing a Geo), Microsoft will store the following Customer Data at rest only within that Geo: (1) Exchange Online mailbox content (e-mail body, calendar entries, and the content of e-mail attachments) and (2) SharePoint Online site content and the files stored within that site.

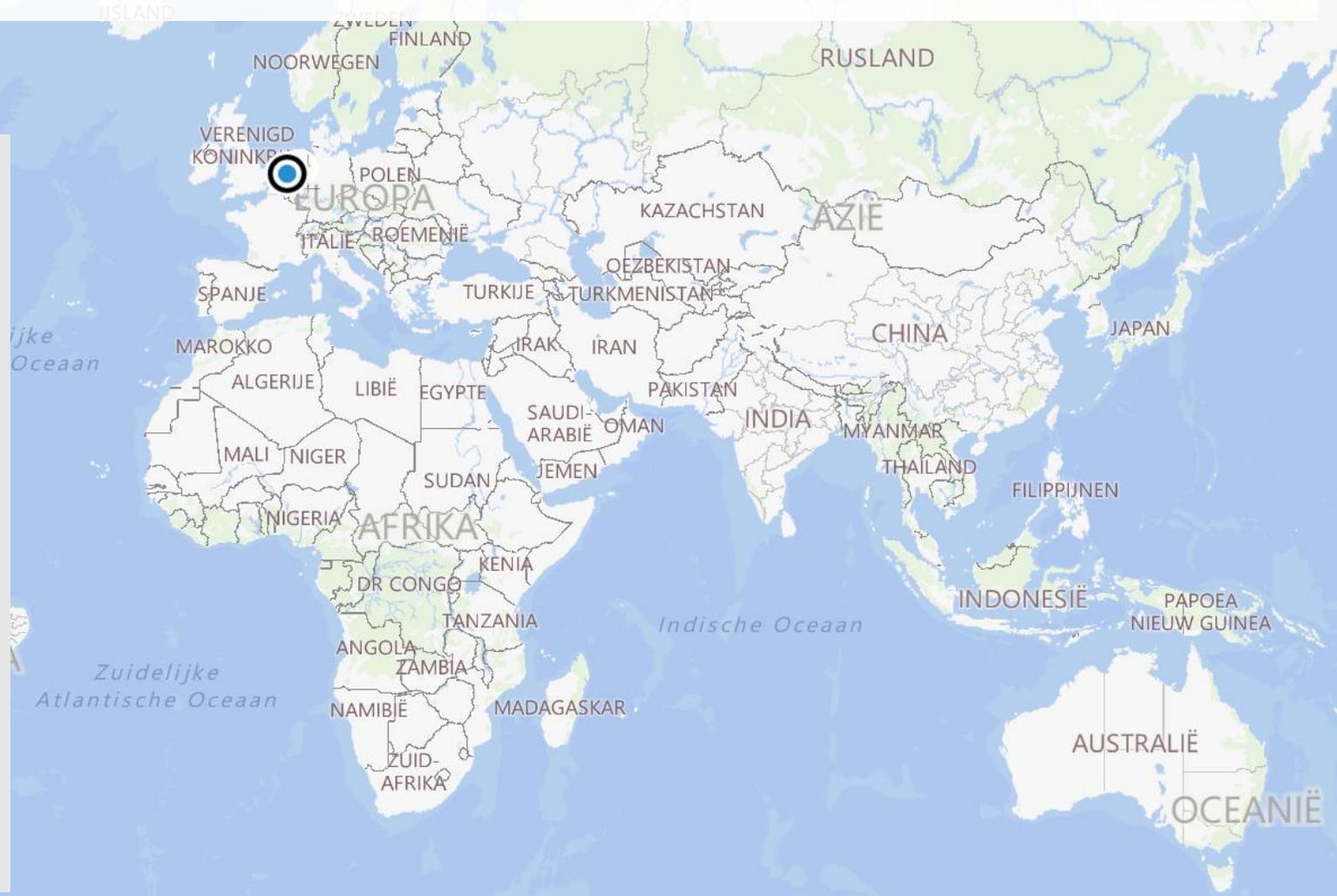
Our search warrant case: An important decision for people everywhere

Today the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit ruled in a case brought by Microsoft addressing the global application of U.S. search warrants for people's email. The court ruled in favor of Microsoft overturning an earlier ruling from a lower court.

We obviously welcome today's decision by the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit. The decision is important for three reasons: it ensures that people's privacy rights are protected by the laws of their own countries (...)

# Government access to data

## Law Enforcement Request report

Only 28 requests for Enterprise Accounts for the same period!

- 12 Rejected, withdrawn or redirected
- 11 Compelled to respond non-content only
- 5 Compelled to respond some content

These numbers include mostly consumer services requests (hotmail/outlook, Skype)

3. Additional customer controls & requirements, empowered by cloud platforms
  - Administrative Privilege Management
  - Identity Systems and Identity Management
  - Threat Awareness & monitoring
  - Data Protection
