To Teachers and Parents:

In this LIFE PAC the children will learn the short /ă/ sound in words. They will learn the sounds of m, n, r, s, t, b, and d as the beginning and ending sounds of words.

Learning to listen and follow directions, grouping things that are alike in some way, putting events in proper sequence, finding main ideas in stories, and retelling stories are important parts of this LIFE PAC.

In the listening exercises the directions are to be read *only once*. Wait until you have the attention of all the children before reading the directions. Move around the room while the children are working to see that they are following the directions exactly as given.

Important: All the lessons in this LIFE PAC are to be directed by the teacher. Step-by-step instructions for teaching each page are found in the Teacher Handbook. A list of activities is included. Some of these activities may be done by the class; some, by slower students for extra drill; and some, by faster students for enrichment. Choose the activities that fit your own class. Supplementary worksheets are correlated with the pages in the text and should be used as indicated in the Teacher Handbook.

The children should use the LIFE PAC Tablet 100-101 for their written work since the lines are spaced the same as in the LIFE PAC.

Word List:

This word list is made up of words introduced at least once in this LIFE PAC. An asterisk (*) following a word indicates a word that the children will need to know by sight to complete the exercises and to take the tests *independently*. A word that appears in this list is not repeated in the lists of the following LIFE PACs. A cumulative word list is included in the Teacher Handbook.

The sight words in each LIFE PAC should be drilled frequently. This drill could be done by the use of a chart posted in a prominent place in the room, by word card drills, or by word recognition and meaning games. Encourage children to make flash cards (word cards) to use at home.
